In a survey conducted by Education Today under the category of India's Top 10 State Board Schools, Little Flower High School was ranked First in Hyderabad, First in Telangana and Ninth in India.

RESULTS:

Due to the pandemic situation the Board of Secondary Education released the SSC results as per the internal assessment marks of the students. Yet again our students made us proud with 74 students scoring GPA 10/10. 133 students in I Language, 158 in II Language,143 in English, 126 in Mathematics, 108 in Science and 129 in Social Studies have scored a GPA of 10. Kudos to the Management and the members of the Staff for their untiring efforts.

Lockdown and closure did not deter us from our goal of setting new standards of achievements. The academic year 2020- 2021 started off with a series of Virtual Orientation Programmes right from LKG to Class 10. The Resource Persons for the same were Mr. L. Ravichander, senior advocate, Mr. Gopi Krishna Pidatala, our alumnus and Mrs Ann Oommen, our senior faculty.

Under the able guidance, supervision and meticulous planning of Rev.Bro.Shajan Antony, our Principal, online classes for Class 10 started on June 10 and on June 12 for Classes II to IX.

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Classes were held on Google Meet. Gsuite accounts were created for all students and staff for the smooth conduct of online classes.

As per the directions given by the government of Telangana, our school was reopened for the students of Classes 9 and 10 on 1st February and for Classes 6, 7 and 8 on 8th March. The Management and staff have left no stone unturned to make all the necessary arrangements following the government protocol for the safety of the students. Rev. Bro. Shajan Antony, our Principal personally supervised all the arrangements. The students were given a hearty welcome by the teachers and the Principal when they arrived in the school after eleven months of school closure. All the SOPs were followed meticulously.

Hosting virtual activities and celebrations have now become a new normal at Little Flower High School. Our students never fail to surprise us with their zeal and enthusiasm. We have set benchmarks in many areas for ourselves and for others. Investiture Ceremony, Independence Day, Teachers' Day, Children's Day, Feast of Saint Teresa our Patron Saint, Gandhi Jayanti, Founder's Day and Republic Day were all celebrated virtually with great enthusiasm.

A virtual Inter Montfort School Carol Singing Competition, Pune Province, was organised by our school on the 19th of December. On the same day the staff of the school organised games stalls. The funds raised from these stalls were used for helping the poor and the needy.

A virtual United Carol Singing Competition for schools and colleges of the twin cities was held in our school on 24th December.

Review of Holistic Education Province of Pune, was a pleasant time to interact virtually with the rest of the Montfort schools. The school cabinet went out of their way to celebrate the Women's Day for their teachers on 8th March.

A Model United Nations (MUN) was organised by the students of Little Flower Degree College, Uppal. 15 students of our school from Classes 8 and 9 attended this session as observers.

The virtual Annual Day Celebrations of our LKG and UKG students were held on 9th and 10th April respectively. Impressive programmes were put up by the teachers to showcase the talents of their tiny tots.

A plethora of multifarious activities were conducted to draw out the innate talents of our students. Literary, Cultural, Games and Sports events were conducted virtually and a large number of students participated in these competitions and bagged many prizes.

As part of the Fit India Marathon 2020, a cycling activity was organised for the students of Classes 5, 6 and 7 to promote the importance of health.

Our students from Classes LKG to 10 displayed their creative skills by bringing out two digital school bulletins-News Bytes, a fortnightly magazine and News Buzz, a monthly journal.

To sharpen the quizzing talents of our students and to prepare them for Quiz Competitions, a Weekly Quiz programme was organized for our students. A large number of students participated in this programme and won many prizes.

Observation of International and National Days was another feature which evoked great response from the students. Here are the highlights of some important events.

LANDSCAPING AND INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT:

To enhance the importance of the theme of this year, 'My Earth, My Responsibility', all open places in the school are arrayed with potted plants. A beautiful vertical garden adds to the landscape of the school. A magnificent aquarium and an attractive Children's Park are a delight to the children in the Primary Section. A water harvesting system has been set up to help in the conservation of water.

A new Activity Room has been designed in the Primary Section to facilitate creative minds with innovative ideas.

To keep abreast with advancement in technology and to upgrade ourselves, the entire school is now digitalized with Wi-Fi connection in all classrooms, labs and office areas. The school library is now completely digitized and we hope our students can begin using it soon.

The school office has been completely renovated and a new boys' washroom has been constructed for the convenience of Middle School students.

Flag Activity

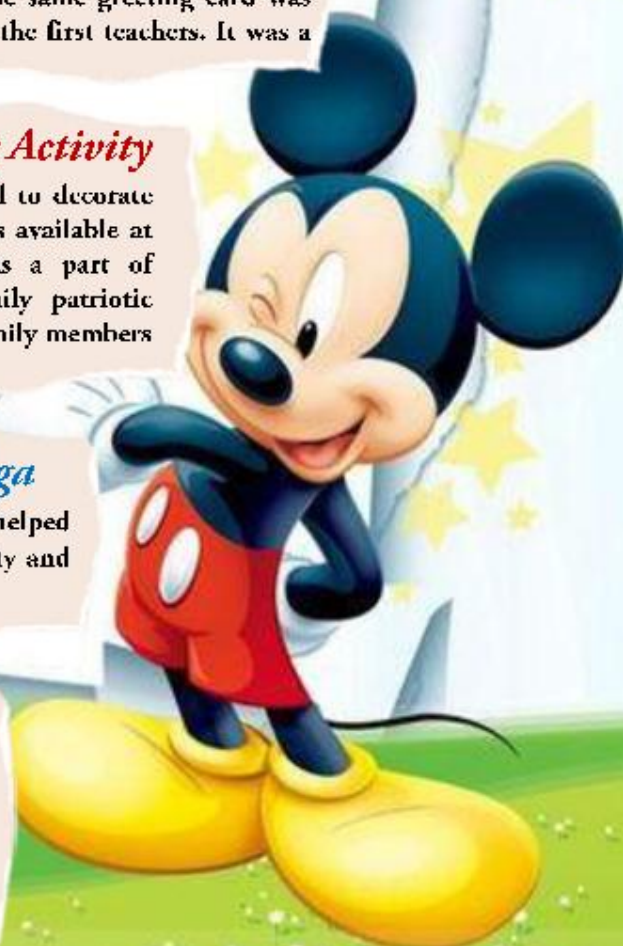

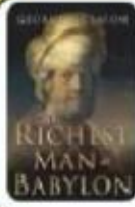


Inspirational Books that can change your life

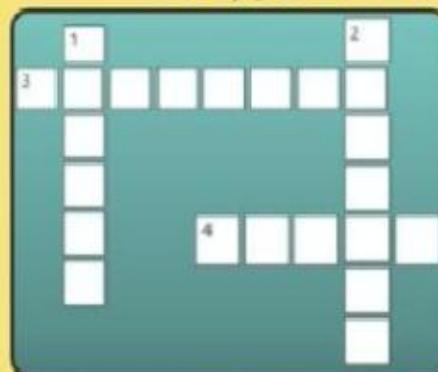

YOUNG CHEFS-RECIPES

BASUNDI

Basundi, is a dessert originated from Western India refers to sweet, thickened milk and garnished with Dry Fruits. For this recipe, we require:

- 1 L of Milk
- Sugar
- Cardamom powder
- Cashew nuts (12-15)
- Dry Fruits(4-5 flaked pistachios and almonds)

1. Soak the Cashew nuts in hot water for about 15 mins; grind into a smooth paste and keep aside

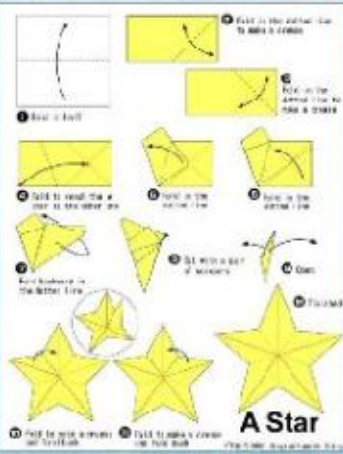

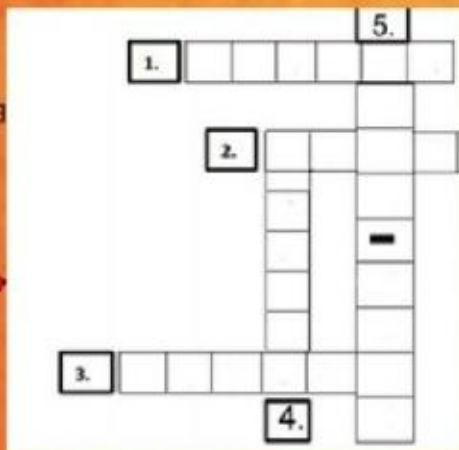

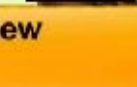

The Rubik's Cube

The Rubik's Cube was invented in 1974 by Erno Rubik, a Hungarian Architect, who wanted a working model to help explain 3-dimensional geometry. After designing "The Magic Cube" as he called it, he realised he could not actually solve the puzzle. The more he moved the coloured squares, the more mixed up they became. "It was a code I myself had invented!" he wrote. "Yet I could not read it." The cube, made up of 9 coloured squares on each side, can be rearranged in 43 quintillion different combinations. That is 43,252,003,274,489,856,000 to be exact. After a month of figuring out how to solve it, he developed a method of solving it. He being from Hungary, then behind the Iron Curtain, it was not easy to explore the possibility of marketing it as a toy. A few years later, it was shown at the Nuremberg Toy Fair in 1979, and was spotted as a potential hit. It was licensed to the Ideal Toy Corp in 1980 and, by January 2009, more than 350 million units had been sold worldwide, making it the biggest selling toy of all time. It won "Toy of the Year" in the UK in both 1980 and 1981. With the advent of popular video games, it's popularity declined over the next few years but had never completely disappeared. Thanks to "Speed Cubing Competitions", which have caught the attention of the enthusiastic speed cubers across the globe. The current world record is held by Yusheng Du, a Chinese Speedcuber, who managed to solve it in 3.47 seconds on 24th October, 2018.

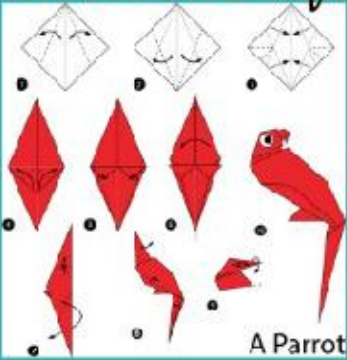

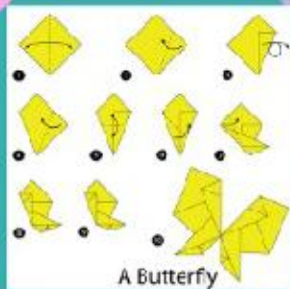

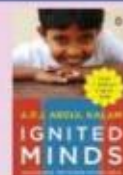

As a young man, he worked at his father's arm factory. While studying in Paris, he met Sobero, an Italian chemist, who invented nitro-glycerin, a highly explosive liquid. Nobel was interested in the use of nitro-glycerin for construction. While experimenting in 1866, he mixed it with a fine sand called "Kieseguhr" that turned liquid into paste. He converted this paste into rods that could then be inserted into drilling holes. Nobel got a patent on this material and named it "dynamite". His work and invention made him a wealthy man. He used this fortune to establish the Nobel Prize. He died on 10th December 1896

Vanilla Cake

Ingredients : Refined flour , Eggs (optional) , Vanilla essence , Baking powder, Baking soda , Powdered sugar, Milk (optional) Melted butter.

PROCEDURE:- Grease the mould and preheat the oven to 180 degree Celsius. Break 3 eggs (optional) in a bowl and whisk it till it becomes white and frothy (But if you don't want eggs use 1 cup of melted butter). Then add 2 cups of powdered sugar to the beaten eggs and mix well. Now add a Teaspoon of vanilla essence. Add 3 cups of refined flour (Maida), 1 teaspoon baking soda, ½ teaspoon baking soda and mix it well. Now put the batter in the greased pan and put it in the oven and bake for 30 min to 45 min. Pierce a toothpick through the cake to check whether its cooked or not. If it comes out clean then it is baked. Let it cool for at least 15 to 20 min. Now is ready to be served.
